PASTOR EDIE'S PONDERINGS

Summertime and the living is easy – at least that's what they tell me! Lots has happened at GFPC – for the good future of the congregation. We've elected the Pastor Nominating Committee and they are hard at work.

Reports of the PNC are each communion Sunday and each Session meeting. We've elected new officers and reduced the number of persons on each Board (Session & Diaconate) to nine (9). Please watch for and respond with your involvement in at least one of the activities of the congregation.

The Session is now responsible for Administrative, Educational, and Mission activities of the Congregation.

The Diaconate is now responsible for womb – to – tomb personal ministry, including attracting potential members, getting folk to join – welcoming Sunshine and Virginia this year so far, sustaining current members in Shepherd Groups and with fellowship activities, and helping with worship services by opening up and assisting with funerals. Third Sunday lunch and other congregational care activities have moved to the Deacons.

Lacey VanPay has accepted the position of office coordinator with changed hours at the request of many. The office is now open for business Monday thru Thursday 9-2 and Fridays 9-12. The Session voted to have just one office position. Welcome, Lacey! Also, David retains Friday as day off; Edie has moved her day off to Monday. You will always be able to contact a pastor should a need arise.

Space usage has been reorganized and remodeling is started. The former pastor's office is now the committee resource room and Deacons preparation for worship space. The space for the office coordinator is now the entry office and workroom. That space flows to the former pastor's office which is now being remodeled to return to its original function. The financial office remains in its space next to the library. (Temporarily the interim pastor is in a corner of the library and the parlor is being used for large meetings.) The interim will move into the pastor's office when it is completed and has promised to 'live lightly' there until the congregation votes on a new head of staff pastor. The associate pastor, music department, and children's nursery all remain in their home spaces. Session accepted a large gift for the remodeling of the former pastor's office back into the pastor's office.

One other small, but significant, item is the resumption of staff meetings for communication coordination. There will be one in mid-July, and then monthly meetings will resume in September.

MARIALICE'S MUSIC NOTES

Sunday, June 3, the Sanctuary Handbells will participate in worship before taking their break for the summer. They will present two pieces for the Opening Voluntary: "Immortal, Invisible God Only Wise" and "God of Amazing Grace".

The first piece is an arrangement of the Welsh folk tune, *St. Denio.* "God of Amazing Grace" was commissioned in 2014 for the 140th anniversary of Grace First. It uses two beloved hymns: "God of Grace and God of Glory" and "Amazing Grace". It was published by Choristers Guild and was one of their top sellers when it was published. The handbells will play again at the Offertory "Somebody's Knocking at Your Door", an arrangement of a traditional Spiritual.

FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR

My daily devotional reading has once again provided a word for me when it is time to write an article for the newsletter. May we all be as close to Christ as He was with God.

Now This Explains It

"That they may all be one. As you, Father, are in me and I am in you, may they also be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me."

John 17:21 (NRSV)

If you are going through a solitary way, read John 17, it will explain exactly why you are where you are – Jesus prayed that you may be one with the Father as He is. Are you helping God to answer that prayer, or have you some other end for your life? Since you became a disciple you cannot be as independent as you used to be.

The purpose of God is not to answer our prayers, but by our prayers we come to discern the mind of God, and this is revealed in John 17. There is one prayer God must answer, and that is the prayer of Jesus – "that they may be one, even as We are One." Are we as close to Jesus Christ as that?

God is not concerned about our plans, He does not say – Do you want to go through this situation; this upset? He allows these things for His own purpose. The things we are going through are either making us sweeter, better, nobler men and women; or they are making us more captious and fault -finding, more insistent upon our own way. The things that happen either make us fiends, or they make us saints; it depends entirely upon the relationship we are in to God. If we say – "Thy will be done," we get the consolation of John 17, the consolation of knowing that our Father is working according to His own wisdom. When we understand what God is after we will not get mean and cynical. Jesus prayed nothing less for us than absolute oneness with Himself as He was one with the Father. Some of us are far off it, and yet God will not leave us alone until we *are* one with Him, because Jesus prayed that we may be.


