Dear Kate Rieves/Caroline Dickerson Scholarship Applicant,

Greetings! We are pleased you are applying for one of our scholarships and look forward to reviewing your application. Follow the directions below to qualify for consideration of a scholarship. Failure to follow the guidelines below or provide the required documentation will disqualify your application.

Here is what we expect from you:

Guidelines for all scholarships

- · Scholarships are awarded annually and paid directly to the school.
- Strong preference is given to members of Grace First; exception might be given to a person who is not a member but has participated in church activities
- A minimum GPA of 2.5 (A = 4.0) must be maintained.
- Enrollment for and completion of a minimum of 12 semester hours in each semester (i.e. remain a full time student) is required for undergraduate students. Graduate applicants are considered on a case-by-case basis.
- If you have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), include your confirmation of application or your Student Aid Report (SAR).
- First time applicants will be scheduled for a mandatory interview with the Board.
- · You may apply for both scholarships but can receive only one.

Additional Guidelines for the Kate Rieves Scholarship

• A student is eligible to receive a Kate Rieves scholarship for up to four years but must reapply each year.

Additional Guidelines for the Caroline Dickerson Scholarship

- An undergraduate student is eligible to receive a Caroline Dickerson scholarship for four years or until he/she receives an undergraduate degree, whichever comes first (full time graduate studies applicants will be considered on a case-by-case basis)
- · Strong preference is given to previous recipients
- · Must be and must remain single
- Applicants receiving a Caroline Dickerson scholarship during the immediate previous year need to complete only the first page of this application, submit a copy of their college transcript and initial here ______.

The following documentation must be submitted to the church office by March 15 of the current year:

- · This letter with signature(s) and date(s)
- · Completed application(s)
- · Any additional information that the committee should consider, including information as to what this scholarship would mean for you financially (in less than 150 words).
- · A copy of your latest transcript.
- · A copy of your latest Student Aid Report (if available).
- · Signed letters of recommendation from two references, who are not members of your family or church and who have not been used in previous years.
