MINISTRIES

The ministries of Grace First are the way in which we are organized to do the "good works" God intends us to do. CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Responsible for the following:

- Calling teachers, facilitators, and volunteers for all Sunday school classes, Bible study classes, Kids Worship, and Vacation Bible School
- Reviewing and recommending curriculum for C.E. classes
- Conducting teacher training and providing support
- Overseeing the LOGOS Advisory Board and lending support when needed
- Coordinating, assisting and supporting the Associate Pastor in the implementation of the youth program
- Maintaining the church library

CONGREGATIONAL LIFE

Responsible for the following:

- Providing opportunities for the congregation to gather for fellowship, spiritual growth, and social activities
- Planning and supporting of sub-groups (including, but not limited to)—Cottage Ministry, Third Sunday Lunch, Men's Breakfast, Sunday Coffee Fellowship, Roadrunners, Prayer Shawl Ministry, and Retreats

FIRST CONNECTION

Responsible for the following:

- Establishing contact with visitors on Sunday mornings
- Providing information about Grace First to visitors
- Introducing visitors to others
- Contacting visitors through cards and calls
- Encouraging visitors to participate

IN TOUCH

Responsible for the following:

- Keeping in contact with nursing home and homebound members through visits, cards, and calls
- Informing the pastor and church office of concerns

MISSION & OUTREACH

Responsible for the following:

- Recommending and implementing ways in which our church can be involved in the mission of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) both locally and beyond
- Allocating designated funds to selected mission projects
- Supporting projects related to (including, but not limited to)— Boy Scouts, Compassion Fund, Grace In Action, Habitat for Humanity, Manna, Presbyterian Children's Homes & Services Bunk House, Presbyterian Night Shelter

PASTORAL CARE

Responsible for the following:

- Coordinating meals/receptions following a Funeral/Memorial service
- Arranging meals for those who have been in the hospital, if needed
- Sending cards to those who are grieving the loss of a loved one or experiencing other personal struggles
